FOOD & SUPPLIES DISTRIBUTION / DONATION CENTERS

GREENE/MONTGOMERY COUNTIES

- Chenaulte Dance Studio (2536 Shiloh Springs Rd, Trotwood): Charging stations, bathrooms, meals to go, fresh fruit, water, toiletry kits for men & women, diapers, wipes, baby blankets. Open Monday – Friday 12 – 9 pm and Saturday – Sunday 12 – 6 pm.
- Dayton Vineyard Church (4051 Indian Ripple Rd, Beavercreek): Open as emergency relief center through June 2nd (12 – 7 pm), distributing food and supplies.
 - Need volunteers to help with distribution and debris removal. Visit <http://dvc.life/relief>
 - Accepting financial contributions and donations of water, non-perishable food (bread, peanut butter, jelly, etc.), snacks, and similar food that does not require cooking (granola bars, bananas, cans of tuna, crackers, etc.). Also need wipes, diapers/pull-ups, cleaning supplies, Gatorade, basic first-aid supplies. Drop off between 7 am – 9 pm in the church's Family Life Center (red door entrance).

- Montgomery County Job & Family Services: Residents on food assistance may be eligible for SNAP Replacement Benefits. If you lost power for more than 4 hours, come to Job Center at 1111 S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd to apply for Replacement Benefits.
- Mt. Enon Baptist Church (1501 W. Third St, Dayton): Shelter, food, water, supplies
- Northridge Church of Christ (2211 Needmore Rd, Harrison Township): Food, personal care kits, baby care kits, cleaning supplies, diapers, shovels, rakes, and wheelbarrows available for pickup between 9 am – 6 pm starting Thursday (5/30). Meals served Monday – Friday, 3 – 6 pm and Saturday and Sunday, 1 – 4 pm.
