

## SHELTERS AND RESOURCES ACROSS THE MIAMI VALLEY

### **GREENE COUNTY**

- Dayton Vineyard Church (4051 Indian Ripple Rd, Beavercreek): Open as emergency relief center through June 2<sup>nd</sup> (12 – 7 pm), distributing food and supplies.
  - Need volunteers to help with distribution and debris removal. Visit <http://dvc.life/relief>
  - Accepting financial contributions and donations of water, non-perishable food (bread, peanut butter, jelly, etc.), snacks, and similar food that does not require cooking (granola bars, bananas, cans of tuna, crackers, etc.). Also need wipes, diapers/pull-ups, cleaning supplies, Gatorade, basic first-aid supplies. Drop off between 7 am – 9 pm in the church's Family Life Center (red door entrance).
- King's Table Bar (2348 Grange Hall Road in Beavercreek): Shelter operated by City of Beavercreek officials (not Red Cross)
- Greene County Parks & Trails (575 Ledbetter, Xenia): Accepting donations of non-perishable foods on Friday, May 31 from 8 am to 4 pm. Each person who donates ten non perishable goods will receive a free ticket to the Joe Diffie concert on Saturday June 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **MONTGOMERY COUNTY**

- The Barrel House (417 E. Third St., Dayton) has free bottled water.
- Corinthian Baptist Church (700 S. James H. McGee Blvd, Trotwood): Red Cross shelter
  - Wireless Emergency Communication Center (powered by the Verizon Communications & Charging Trailer) also available: Charging stations for electronic devices, computer workstations, wireless phones and tablets (and other devices) to contact family/friends/other important contacts.
- Dayton Art Institute: Free admission on Thursday (5/30) from 11 am – 8 pm to use charging stations. Free ice distributed from 8 am – 8 pm.
- Dayton Public Schools: Valerie PreK -6: Open Thursday (5/30) and Friday (5/31), 8 am – 5 pm, for free bottled water and outlets to charge phones/devices.
- Diversity Salon (37 Hillside Court, Englewood): Offering free shampoos, bottled water and food until power comes back on for area residents. Located near Brookville and Trotwood.
- East End Community Services (624 Xenia Avenue, Dayton): Accepting donations of bottled water, non-perishable food items, cleaning supplies, and baby care items, personal hygiene items.
- Gateway Cathedral (5501 Olive Rd, Trotwood): Water available beginning 8 am Thursday. Bring containers to get drinkable water.

- George’s Family Restaurant (5216 N. Dixie Drive): Free food and water while supplies last
- Ginghamburg Church - Fort McKinley Campus (3721 W. Siebenthaler Ave, Trotwood): Open for those seeking shelter and bottled water is available.

  - Donations accepted at Precious Blood Gym all day on 5/30
- Puerto-Rican American and Caribbean Organization (PACO): Accepting donations for the community at Dayton International School Spanish Immersion Academy (5700 FALL HILLS AVE) on Thursday from noon-6PM, Friday 8AM-6PM, and Saturday 8AM-4PM.
